Term 3 has now started and we have a very busy term planned for the next ten weeks.

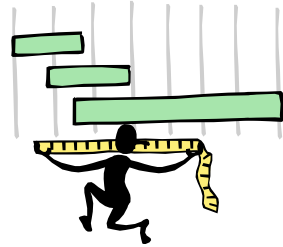
The classroom programmes are in full swing with the students working on a Unit of work entitled "Show Me the Money".
